Structure of the Programme

The joint Master's Programme of the National University of Kyiv Mohyla Academy (NaUKMA) and Friedrich Schiller University Jena, Germany, is a two-year, full-time social science study programme, which includes a half-year stay at Jena University for selected students. About 50 percent of teaching is conducted in German – 50 percent is held in English and Ukrainian.

Successful students are awarded an MA degree in Political Science with a specialisation in German and European Studies according to international double degree regulations. The seperate German and Ukrainian M.A. certificates enable the student to use the academic grade in both Germany and Ukraine.
